

Organize Your Story – Mary Ann’s Example

<p>The Moral to Your Story: (Driving theme, Character of God you are highlighting)</p> <p><i>God of Miracles</i> - Give God the desires of your heart, make Him Lord, and let Him preform a miracle in you.</p>
<p>Opening / transitioning into your story (Question, statement, scripture, statistic, etc.)</p> <p>Our God is not a God of Statistics; He is a God of miracles!</p>
<p>Body of your story: Illustration / 1st point (Share enough to bring your story alive, but not dilute it’ main message)</p> <p>Stat: Perception of feeling like 1/million Dallas; 1 man for every 3 ladies (all beautiful), hard to find a man over 40 that still wants to have children</p> <p>Scripture: Psalms 37:4 <i>“Delight yourself in the Lord and he will give you the desires of your heart”</i></p> <p>Get 2 things straight:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• 5 C’s Criteria; Christian, Compatible, Communication, Commitment, and Chemistry• Become the woman that man will want to marry <p>First statistic buster – Don Mariani</p>
<p>Body: Illustration / 2nd Point</p> <p>Stat: Getting pregnant at 43 – 2% chance Fertility help or not?</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Foster Care Route• Pregnant God’s way <p>Second statistic buster – Jordan Grace Mariani – Born February 25, 2003</p>
<p>Body: Illustration / 3rd point (Optional)</p>
<p>Concluding Your Story: Conclude with a tie back to God’s character, a scripture, and/or how He may be able to do the same for your listener(s)</p> <p>“If the statistics in your life aren’t going as you desire – hand them over to God, make Him the Lord of your life, and He will get the numbers right!”</p>
